

Harry Stuart HUTCHISON

Harry Hutchison was born in 1886. He completed his law degree in 1908 and was admitted to practice in 1910. He was practicing as a solicitor in February 1916 when he enlisted with the medical corps at Ballarat. After completing his training, and with the rank of corporal, he departed for Egypt in August 1916 and arrived in September 1916. He was assigned to the No 14 Australian General Hospital in Cairo, and worked there until the end of the war, reaching the rank of staff sergeant. He would have cared for the men who were wounded during the campaigns in Palestine.

In 1919, Hutchison went to London and undertook a legal studies course for four months. In August 1919, he re-joined the medical corps for the voyage home to Australia and arrived back in Australia in October 1919.

He returned to work as a solicitor in Melbourne. He died in 1968.
