### *DO YOU KNOW MORE ABOUT THIS STORY?*

George Pitcher's inclusion on the board is a mystery as we have been unable to trace any service records for him for the First World War.

We do know that Pitcher completed his articles and was admitted to practice in 1916. Eventually he had his own legal practice in Little Collins street. Active in the Law Institute of Victoria (LIV), he was elected to the LIV Council in 1928 and was president in 1932-33. His firm became Pitcher and Butt, which later became part of McKean Park.

George Pitcher died on 6 December 1940.
