

Charles Lachlan Mackinnon TEMPLETON

Charles Templeton was born in Brighton in 1875 and was 40 years old when he enlisted at the Melbourne Town Hall on 27 November 1915. Previously a solicitor, at the time of his enlistment, he was an Examiner of Titles.

Templeton's time in the army was brief and, by April 1916, he had been discharged. Charles Templeton suffered from asthma and was considered unfit for service.

He appears to have returned to his former occupation as an Examiner of Titles, and for a brief period was also the Master of Equity and Lunacy at the Supreme Court, in 1922 and 1923. He left the Court to take up an appointment as in-house counsel.

Charles Templeton died in September 1940.
